

Broward County Transit (BCT) provides Hurricane Evacuation Assistance in the event of a hurricane evacuation to residents who are unable to make other arrangements for transportation to designated shelters.

Call the Hurricane Hotline at 954-831-4000 for BCT evacuation pick-up point locations.

When an evacuation is ordered, BCT discontinues its regular service and begins emergency/evacuation service. Evacuation service coincides with the opening of American Red Cross shelters. It will not begin before shelters are open.

Evacuation pick-up points are located along A1A on the beaches, and along A1A and Federal Highway in a Category 3 Hurricane or higher. Persons evacuating from these areas can flag down a BCT bus for pick-up. There are also designated pick-up points where buses will lay over longer to take evacuees.

- ◆ When regular bus service is discontinued, the BCT telephone information center will close.
- ◆ Local radio and television updates will announce when normal Broward County Transit bus service resumes, or call the Hurricane Hotline at 954-831-4000.
- ◆ Regular bus service is resumed only after the “All Clear” is given for safe travel on local streets.
- ◆ A reverse evacuation will be conducted. This means you will be returned to your original pick-up point only after the “All Clear” is given by the County.
